- If it is an objective compliment
- If it is a congnate
- If it is an adverbial qualification of purpose
- If it is an adverbial qualification of time or place
- If it is a *ma'* accusative
- If it is an exceptive
- If it is an *h^āḥ* accusative
- If it is an specificative
- If it is a vocative
- If it is a predicate of the verb *kana*
- If it is an inchoative of the preposition *inna*
