

The Maccusative

102. What is the *maccusative*?

The *maccusative* is a noun in the accusative state mentioned after a *with* that has the meaning of with. For example: ماتَ المريضُ و طلوعَ الشمسِ (The patient died with the rising of the sun.)

103. What are the conditions of the *maccusative*?

The conditions for the *maccusative* is that it is preceded by:

- A verbal sentence: سِر و الشَّارِعَ (Travel by the street.)
- Or, the interrogative *maccusative*: ما شأنك و أخاهُ (What is your status with his brother?)
- Or, the interrogative *kayf*: كيف أنتَ و العلمَ (How are you with respects to knowledge?)

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
