

## 22. Etiquette of the Hajj

عَنْ أَبِي جَعْفَرٍ (ع) قَالَ: مَا يَعْبُوُ بِمَنْ يَوْمَ هَذَا الْبَيْتِ إِذَا لَمْ يَكُنْ فِيهِ ثَلَاثُ خِصَالٍ: وَرَعٌ يَحْجُزُهُ عَنِ مَعَاصِي اللَّهِ وَحِلْمٌ يَمْلِكُ بِهِ غَضَبَهُ وَحُسْنُ الصَّحَابَةِ لِمَنْ صَحِبَهُ.

It has been narrated from Abi Ja'far [Imam Muhammad Ibn 'Ali al-Baqir] (peace be upon him) that he said, "It does not matter if one visits this House if he does not possess three traits: Cautiousness (Wara') which prevents him from sinning; forbearance which helps him rule over his anger; and good interaction with those who are with him."
