15. Words are made up of:

- One letter, for example the *bā* preposition in بِحَمْدِ اللَّهِ (with the praise of Allah)
- More than one letter (up to seven letters). For example: اسْتِخْبَارٌ (inquiry)

16. Morphology teaches us the forms of single words and their different states before being joined together with other words.

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
