21. A regular verb is a verb that is without any extra letters. For example: **كَتَبَ دَحْرَجَ** (he rolled, he wrote)

22. There are two categories of regular verbs:

- Trilateral; for example: **نَصَرَ كَرُمَ** (he respected, he helped)
- Quadrilateral; for example: **دَحْرَجَ زَلَزَلَ** (he shook, he rolled)

23. Trilateral verbs with increase letters have one, two or three letters added to the original letters of the verb. For example: **أَكْرَمَ اجْتَمَعَ اسْتَغْفَرَ** (he asked for forgiveness, he gathered, he respected)

Quadrilateral verbs with increase letters have one or two letters added to the original letters of the verb. For example: **تَدَحْرَجَ اقشَعَرَ** (he shuddered, he rolled)

24. There are ten forms for the trilateral verbs with increase letters:

فَعَّلَ فَاعَلَ أَفْعَلَ

تَفَعَّلَ تَفَاعَلَ اِنْفَعَلَ اِنْفَاعَلَ اِفْعَلَ اِفْعَالَ

إِسْتَفْعَلَ إِفْعَوْلًا
