60. An apalistic noun is a noun that is not derived from another word. For example: رَجُلٌ دِرْهَمٌ (dirham, man)

61. A derived noun is a noun that is derived from another word. For example: عَالِمٌ مَعْلُومٌ (something known, a scholar). Both of these words are derived from the word عِلْمٌ (knowledge).

62. Derived nouns are: active participles, passive participles, comparatives, superlatives and epithets.

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
