92. The nomen vicis is an infinitive that intends to denote the singleness of the action. This noun is formed from trilateral verbs in the form **فَعَلَةٌ** , for example: **مَشِيَّةٌ**, and from other than three letter verbs in the same form as its infinitive, ending in the feminine **تُ**, for example: **إِنطِلاقَةٌ**.

93. The nomen speciei is an infinitive that denotes the form of the action. This noun is formed from trilateral verbs in the form **فَعَلَةٌ**, for example: **مَشِيَّةٌ**, from other than three letter verbs in the same form as its infinitive, ending in the feminine **تُ**, exactly like the nomen vicis, for example: **التَّفَاتَةُ العَفْزَالِ**.

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
